

TWELVE ANGRY MEN SCHOLARSHIP TO THE NATIONAL CRIMINAL DEFENSE COLLEGE IN MACON,  
GEORGIA

Members in good standing of the New York State Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers (NYSACDL) are eligible to apply for a scholarship to the annual Trial Practice Institute presented by the National Criminal Defense College in Macon, Georgia. This scholarship is funded by money raised by the Association's production of *Twelve Angry Men*.

This year, the College will be held on June 13 – 26 and July 18 – 31, 2010. Each session is limited to 96 participants. The participants are grouped based on trial experience; the groups then receive group instruction and daily exercises on areas ranging from client interviews to all facets of trial preparation and presentation. Lectures and faculty demonstrations supplement the small group sessions.
